This month I was able to attend several patriotic and veteran centered activities. On July 29, I observed the dedication of a Blue Star Memorial Marker honoring all members of the Armed Forces in the Honor Garden at Chestnut Ridge Park. Tributes were offered by Mark C. Poloncarz, Erie Co. Exec., and Michael P. Kearns, NYS ASM, 142nd Dist. High praise for their contribution to this ceremony goes to American Legion Post 567: Commander Joe Cash, Auxiliary President Liz Cash, and American Legion Riders President Bob Youngs.

On August 2, I enjoyed the dining experience of a Civil War Era Banquet conducted in association with static displays hosted by Most Precious Blood Parish in Angola, NY. The displays represented aspects of Reynolds' Battery L, 1st New York Light Artillery. The banquet menu featured period selections such as Mullagatawny Soup, venison, rabbit stew, hasenpfeffer, dandelions, cabbage stew, corn bread, sweet potato bread, maple rice pudding, and Artillery Punch. The present day Reynolds' Battery is over 25 years old and is chartered by the NYS Board of Education. Its stated purpose and objectives are to inform, instruct, and educate the public of the life and trials of a Civil War Artillery soldier during the 1860s.

On August 8, I attended the Welcome Home Veterans 2015 at the Naval Park. There were numerous representatives of organizations that provide services to veterans, veterans' service organizations, and vendors. The weather was beautiful and the activity was well attended.

On August 15, I participated in the 7th and 8th District Membership Workshop in Shortsville, NY. Erie County was well represented.
