I attended typical summer activities this month. First up was the annual 7th & 8th District Membership Workshop. Some highlights that I took away from the workshop: The Department Quota for 2017 is 107,750, Erie County Quota is 6,815, and the first target cut-off date to achieve 50% is September 12. Some selling points that membership reps have found productive are being familiar with the Department Legislative Agenda found on the Department website and charitable contributions made by your own Post during the past year. The Department Commander announced that anyone who recruits one new member will receive a Department Commander's membership pin. It was emphasized that Post #1 transfer documentation MUST have the member's signature. Post enhancements for membership recruitment purposes can be reimbursed by Department. The process for this is further described in the Awards Manual that is available on the Department website. The fact that the American Legion is a family of organizations was also elaborated on. We heard from the Auxiliary, the Sons, and the Legion Riders. All offer a variety of activities that could interest various members of a veteran's family. These are also selling points to present to a prospective member.

Two activities that will draw a large number of veterans will take place next month. Erie County will have a table/tent at both activities. The first, Armed Forces Retiree Appreciation Day will take place on September 17 in the Multi-Purpose Heritage Center at the Niagara Falls Air Reserve Station. Registration occurs 7:45 - 8:45AM. The other activity is the Army/UB Football game on September 24 at the UB Stadium. We hope to attract new members at both of these activities.

Let's all continue to be proud advocates of the American Legion, because membership is all of our responsibility.
