Commander's Message:

In the month of October our nation celebrated the recognized discovery of the "New World". In that new world our nation was created and established on the concept of freedom for all. Recently the symbol of that freedom, our Flag, has become the center of a controversy concerning the freedom of speech. As a result of a motion passed at our October county meeting, a letter was sent to the Buffalo Bills from the Office of the Erie County Committee of the American Legion concerning this controversy. It reflected the sentiment of our National Commander. She lamented the politicization of our National Anthem and proper respect of the Flag that used to be a display of unity at NFL games across the country. The letter explained that the American Legion Family in WNY encourages freedom of speech, but found associated disrespect of the Flag and our National Anthem to be offensive. A copy of the U.S. Flag Code was also sent with the letter.

The Erie County American Legion Family has been well represented in and supportive of many activities throughout October. These included the 8th District Meeting in Wellsville, the Department Membership Workshop in Leroy, the Homeless female Vets 5K Race/Walk at South Buffalo Post #721, and the National Commander's visitation dinner at Wheatfield Post #1451 in Niagara County.
