Membership – VC Suzanne Quirk

Erie County was well represented at the Mid-Winter Conference conducted in Albany from the 20th to the 22nd of January 2017. Our membership numbers were praiseworthy. The data reported from Department as of 1/18/17 was used at the conference. Based on that Erie County is at 84.43% of goal. The target goal for 17JAN was 80% and we surpassed that. The target goal for 6FEB is 85% and we're within 1% of that. I believe we should be able to achieve the February target goal too. My congratulations and deep thanks go out to all of the membership chairpersons for their hard work and dedication. Our efforts also helped Department to achieve membership recruitment of 83.17% of goal. So overall, the atmosphere at the membership meetings was upbeat. Our work is not finished yet, so please carry on with the same perseverance you've demonstrated so far.

The Department Commander will be visiting the 8th District at the end of January and the beginning of February. He will visit Erie County on 3FEB. John Sampson, our Department Commander is awarding a pin for those who have signed up one or more new members for the 2017 membership year. Our current data shows that Erie County has recruited 156 new members so far. The form to request these pins is in the "Department Membership Program & Awards Manual" that can be downloaded. I also have copies of these forms. It's very easy to complete, and provides a way to recognize those who were able to recruit just one new member. I'm recommending that any Legionnaire who has recruited new members and is attending the Department Commander's visitation dinner to bring a completed form to receive a pin. The form can also be sent to Department to report those who have earned pins to be presented at a later time. Again, thank you to everyone who takes the phrase "Membership is everyone's responsibility" seriously.

The Buffalo VA Western New York Healthcare System and the American Legion Auxiliary will be hosting the **National Veterans Creative Arts Festival** from October 23 – October 29, 2017. The Festival began in 1981 in Waco Texas, VA Medical Center as VETS ARTS. Over the years the program has grown and in 1989 became the **NVCAF**. It was designed to spotlight the five creative arts therapies of art, music, dance, drama, and creative writing.

The NVCAF continues to evolve each year as it showcases the artistic achievements of Veterans from across the country. Each Festival features an art exhibit showing the first place artwork from 51 categories. On the last day, Sunday, Oct. 29, a live stage show, with orchestral accompaniment is performed by Veterans. Art workshops and a writing seminar are offered during the Festival week for participants and staff, educating them in a variety of artistic modalities by utilizing the talents of local community artists. There is no competition at the Festival itself, as it is a showcase for previously judged medal winners, held locally at the various VA Hospitals in January or February, the winner advances on to National competition.

In 2016, 3,251 Veterans from 126 VA medical facilities entered the competitions. Of those, approximately 140 medal-winning Veterans were invited to the 2016 NVCAF in Jackson, Mississippi, hosted by the G.V. (Sonny) Montgomery VA Medical Center.

In October 2017, the venue will be at the Adams Mark Hotel in Buffalo NY and the live stage show on Sunday, October 29, will be held at UB Center for the Arts in Amherst, NY. The American Legion Auxiliary's responsibility for the 8 day period is planning, supplying, and hosting the hospitality suite. As the Dept. of NY American Legion Auxiliary is the host we are responsible for getting volunteers and donations for the suite such as water bottles, juices (regular and sugar free), granola bars, snacks, fruits, veggies, etc. Letters will go out to local business' asking for donations for such items.

I am very excited about this festival coming to Buffalo, NY. With donations from Auxiliary Units, Legion Posts, Sons of the Legion and Legion Riders this will help with the cost and make this Festival a great success.
