From December 4-11, 2017 Paul Woods returned to the nation he helped defend in WWII and was given a hero's welcome. The US Embassy covered the event on its live Twitter feed. Paul Woods was accompanied by his daughters Paulette Woods, Commander of the Jesse Clipper American Legion Post#430, and RN Linnette Woods-Ingram.
