- The County judges must make their choice strictly on the merit of the contents of the resume. To insure impartiality in judging the Name, Gender, Post Name, Number, and their Community of the candidate, MUST be omitted from the resume. Any activities or elected office above Post Commander should NOT appear on the resume as well. RESUMES THAT DO NOT CONFORM TO THE ABOVE RULES WILL NOT BE JUDGED!!!
- Posts submit the resume of their candidates to Chairman Kathleen Garvey at her home address 320 Crosby Ave. Kenmore, NY 14217, May 2019 date TBD, along with a resume cover sheet that will identify the candidate, his/her Post name, number, and relative information that has been omitted from the resume. Cover sheets MUST be sealed in a plain white envelope and attached to the resume.
- The resume cannot be submitted posthumously.
