In order for our voice to be heard, the number and support of the constituents or members is very important. That's why we spend a lot of time and energy to maintain and increase our membership. At this time of year the rate of membership growth slows down, but I am happy to say it is still growing. As of 4/25, Erie County's % of membership goal is 91.54, showing an increase since 4/11. Two of our Posts in Erie County were recognized at the 8th District Meeting on 4/2. They received American Legion Birthday Citations which are awarded by Department to Posts whose membership as of March 6, 2017 exceeds their total 2016 membership. These citations were awarded to Thomas E. Tehan and Francis J. Donovan. Congratulations and thanks go to these Posts for their hard work and success. We have other membership statistics to highlight in Erie County. 10 Posts are at 95% of goal or higher. Since 4/11 Erie County gained 31 traditional members, 8 new members and 1 PUFL member. All of that effort is much appreciated. Our final goal of 100% is to be achieved by 5/5. We have 3 posts that have reached that 100% goal. There are Posts at 95% or higher who are in a good position to attain the 100% goal by the target date. I am very proud of the progress that Erie County has made and is still making. To aid in this I will have membership forms and related supplies at the next county meeting. As we draw to the end of another Erie County Committee business year I would like to say it has been my privilege to be part of the Erie County Membership Team.
