**Veteran's Post Restoration - Jerry Kowalski** South Buffalo Post #721 - Remodel restrooms to ADA accessibility, and for exiting the building. Estimated Cost \$100,000. Received NYS Grant thru Assemblyman Michael Kearns. FJ Donovan Post #1626 - Repaired electrical panel, replace outside lights with LED lights, new electrical wires to restrooms, upgrade electrical outlets and timers around Post. Cost \$10,000. Funding by selling Flags at the Auto Bureau. F. Gierlach Post #1320 - Build Handicapped accessible restrooms & interior route addition. Estimated Cost \$90,000. Funded by Russell Salvatore, \$50,000 to complete the project. West Seneca Post #735 - Make building entry accessible, with sidewalk and ramp. Enlarge restroom area to make it ADA compliant. Estimated Cost \$100,000. Received Grants from Bank on Buffalo for \$20,000 and the Wendt Foundation for \$25,000. Labor was donated. This Next project, Matthew Glab Post #1477 - in 2020.
